This permit is granted upon the following conditions, and the cutting or the taking of any forest products under this permit makes all conditions binding:

- 1. Material cut under this permit is for the personal use of the Permittee and shall not be resold or traded.
- 2. Only material marked or designated by the Idaho Department of Lands shall be cut; manufacturing operations will not be permitted on state land.
- 3. The Permittee will do everything in his/her power to prevent and suppress forest fires; will pile all slash and other refuse; and will repair all damage to roads, trails, fences, ditches, and telephone lines resulting from operations under this permit.
- 4. The Permittee agrees to assume all liability for injury, death, or damage which might result from his/her exercise of the rights granted by this permit.
- 5. The Permittee agrees not to travel on wet roads when this will cause ruts or otherwise damage them. Roads and ditches will be kept free of debris and will not be blocked to travel. This permit does not constitute the right of access across private land.
- 6. The Permittee agrees to comply with all state fire regulations and all other rules, regulations and statutes governing state timber and state lands.
- 7. The Permittee will carry this permit with him/her at all times when cutting and removing material from said lands.
- 8. Refunds, extensions, or transfer of this permit to another location will not be permitted.
